MILITARIA AUCTION LIMITED – Licensed Auctioneer

1. Entry to the Venue is by Catalogue and the Payment of \$10.00 Entry Fee. At the time of registering, your name, address, firearms licence, and endorsement details will be recorded and your bidding number issued.
2. All items listed in this catalogue are offered for sale and incur the following Terms & Conditions.
3. Purchase of this catalogue, registering as a bidder and bidding in any form on any lots, is automatic acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admittance to any individual or group or acceptance of a postal bid.
5. Although every effort has been made to describe each lot accurately no warranty is given. The Auctioneer acts as an agent only and neither the Auctioneer, nor the vendors are responsible for errors of description or for the genuineness or authenticity of any lot or for any fault or defect in it, and make no warrant whatsoever.
6. All lots are sold as collectors items only and are not sold as suitable for any other purpose.
7. We cannot accept any responsibility if items are not in working order as no internal inspection of mechanisms have been made. If in doubt about the condition of the bore or the safety of a firearm or ammunition consult a gunsmith.
8. German Items - Due to the large number of reproductions including some from original moulds and dies, no guarantee of authenticity can be given.
9. While items are catalogued with all care, all purchasers including postal bidders must satisfy themselves to the authenticity of any lot and proceed upon their own judgement.
10. All lots sold subject to the right of the seller or their agent to impose a reserve.
11. This Auction includes some entries from vendors "IN TRADE"
12. The Auctioneer will ensure all care during the transportation, display and storage of items. However the agreement to Auction on behalf of the Vendor indemnifies the Auctioneer from any loss or damage to items incurred.
13. The highest bid recognized by the Auctioneer at the fall of the hammer is deemed the purchaser, subject to the Auctioneer having the right to refuse bidding of any person. Any disputes arising during the course of the Auction will be immediately settled by putting the lot in dispute up for resale from the last undisputed bid or the Auctioneer may declare the purchaser.
14. **A Buyers Premium of 13% plus GST on "buyers premium only" will be charged on the hammer price.**
15. The lots are at buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer and are to be taken away at the buyers expense, in default of which the Auctioneer shall not be held liable for any items lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed as they have been left at the sole risk of the purchaser.
"All insurance including in transit, is the responsibility of the purchaser at the fall of the hammer".
16. Bidders attending the auction will be required to pay for the lots during or at the conclusion of the auction by cash or EFTPOS. VISA and MASTERCARD facilities will be available to bidders in attendance at the venue. Cheques will only be accepted by prior approved arrangement. We prefer Postal bidders to pay by online banking.
17. Bidders who are unable to attend the auction, may submit postal bids for any lot or lots specified, provided the following procedure is observed, viz:
18. Using the Postal Bidding Form fill in the lot number from the description in the text and the maximum bid for each lot and send in a sealed envelope to arrive by 5 p.m. Wednesday the 11th of October 2017 to:

Please ensure that your name and address is written legibly on the Postal Bidding Form, together with details of your firearms licence including the endorsements held. **"Postal Bidders Forms must be signed"**

If your parcel delivery address is different from your postal address please print it legibly in the space provided on the Postal Bidding Form. As couriers are unable to deliver to P.O Boxes it may be more convenient for delivery to be made to your work place. (i.e. someone must be able to accept between Mon-Fri 8am-4pm)

Note that under the 1983 Arms Act all postal purchases of firearms must be approved by a sworn member of Police.

Ammunition Postal Bidders Note: Owing to the escalating costs and difficulties associated with the cartage of ammunition within New Zealand, we no longer accept postal bids on ammunition. One way around this problem is for you to arrange for someone attending the auction to buy and carry on your behalf, under the provisions of their own licence.

Overseas Postal Bidders Note: No overseas postal bids on ammunition will be accepted. A service charge will be made for any New Zealand Government Departments, postal services or freight forwarder's documentation that may be required before items can be exported overseas. It is the responsibility of individual prospective bidders to check the legal status of any items in their own country before bidding.

Only Successful bidders will be notified by mail.

Successful bidders will be requested to forward by return mail the cost of the lot purchased being the hammer price plus a Buyers Premium of 13%, plus GST on "buyers premium", plus the cost of postage, freight and packing. Failing receipt of the money owing, the buyers rights will be forfeited and a cancellation fee will be charged.

Successful Postal Bidders are able to settle their account by cheque, bank draft (payable to "MILITARIA AUCTION LTD"), our Preferred Payment is by Online Banking 06-0574-0110217-00. VISA, MASTERCARD are available – but there is an additional cost: Paying by Visa or Mastercard with the "Card Not Present" will incur an additional 2% charge on the total of the invoice.

As postal bids come to hand, lot numbers and bids will be noted in order of receipt and if identical bids for any lot are received then the bid that arrived first will take precedence.

It is the responsibility of all purchasers to obtain the necessary permits to procure before any restricted or registered item can be uplifted. **An Arms Officer will be in attendance on Saturday ONLY!!!**. The Police have advised that anyone purchasing an antique pistol at the auction must have a firearms licence. If you are bidding on parts or components for restricted or registered firearms please ensure you have the appropriate firearms licence endorsements. **Pistol Club Buyers** need a LEV/1 Pink form from their club armourer.

Estimates listed in the catalogue are intended as a guide only. Estimates exclude buyers premium, G.S.T. and are in New Zealand Dollars. Some items may be subject to vendors reserves. The "#" sign indicates the item has been photographed. Glassed items or china are couriered at buyers risk, we recommend you have them collected. WHEN BIDDING "**Bid from the lot number description in the text**, not on the photograph number"

Identification: You must have photographic proof of identification! (Bring your firearms licence if you have one).

Auction: Saturday 14th of October 2017 - starting at 9 a.m. sharp!, until 1050 lots approximately and continuing on from 9 a.m. Sunday 15th of October 2017 until conclusion of auction, approximately mid afternoon.

Venue: St Patrick's College, 581 Evans Bay Parade, Kilbirnie, Wellington.

Registration and Viewing: is from 6.00 pm to 9.00 pm Friday 13th of October, 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. Saturday 14th of October and then 8.00am to 9.00am Sunday 15th October 2017.
